

Goudsmit Statement on RoHS 3 – Directive 2011/65/EU

The European RoHS Directive restricts the use of the hazardous substances specified below in electrical and electronic equipment. The maximum concentration values of the restricted substances by weight in homogenous materials as stated in the RoHS 3 Directive are:

- Lead 0.1%
- Mercury 0.1%
- Cadmium 0.01%
- Hexavalent Chromium 0.1%
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB) 0.1%
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE) 0.1%
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) Phthalate (DEHP) 0.1%
- Butyl Benzyl Phthalate (BBP) 0.1%
- Dibutyl Phthalate (DBP) 0.1%
- Diisobutyl Phthalate (DIBP) 0.1%

Goudsmit declares that, to the best of our knowledge, all the electrical and electronic equipment and components therefore, it produces, and the purchased components therein and those used in mechanical equipment are compliant with the requirements of the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU, amending Directive (EU) 2017/2102 and the amendment on Annex II of Directive (EU) 2015/863.
